Course Description

This online course is composed of weekly, interactive Sunday classes live on Zoom, video lectures and demonstrations, audio lectures, and other downloadable resources. Each two-hour Sunday Class begins with a devotional, followed by an in-depth lecture with Dr. Joyce Choe and Mercy Ballard. Teaching Methods

A variety of instructional methods are used in teaching at Med Missionary. Delivery methods include:

- *Online devotional presentations using PowerPoints; PDFs; pictures*
- *Online interactive instruction; screen-sharing documents, etc.*
- *Video Lectures, evidence-based information; PowerPoints; pictures; peer-reviewed article quotations*
- *AudioLectures; PDF notes; PowerPoints*
- *Video Demonstrations; recipe lists*



Assessment Methods

Completion counts as part of the process towards assessment. When all learning areas are complete, tests will automatically be available to complete at the pace of the learner, keeping in mind the assessment deadline.

Online Tests format are multiple choice questions. There is a total of 7 short tests as indicated in the table below:
