Assessments Pass Rate

Online tests are composed of multiple-choice questions.

There is a total of 3 tests:

1 Health Lecture test

1 History of the Medical Missionary Work test

1 Health in the Bible test

Students must achieve 80% or higher on each test to obtain a certificate of completion. Tests can be re-taken as many times as necessary up until the test deadline.
